### **Trenton Education Dance Institute Receives Community Foundation Grant**

Trenton, NJ ---- Trenton Education Dance Institute (TEDI) received a \$10,000 grant from the Princeton Area Community Foundation, the community foundation serving Mercer County and central New Jersey. The grant supports TEDI's arts youth development program in partnership with The Children's Home Society of New Jersey KIKS program (Kids Intervention with Kids) which takes place at Grace M. Dunn Middle School in Trenton. TEDI is one of 23 organizations to receive funding through the Community Foundation's Greater Mercer Grant Program. Grants totaling over \$470,000 were awarded to local nonprofits for a full-range of community building, program and operating support.

The funds will be used for general program support that gives Trenton public school children the chance to develop socially, emotionally and creatively through the discipline of dance to engage them and motivate them towards excellence.
