

Body & Soul

Body & Soul is a 36-hour March of Dimes prenatal health program for pregnant Women and Women of childbearing age. The program's holistic approach includes a customized curriculum focused on healthy lifestyle choices and promoting harmony between mind and body to reduce stress for a healthy pregnancy and a healthy life.



Improving Pregnancy Outcomes (IPO)

The Improving Pregnancy Outcomes Program: Every Woman Counts provides a variety of free health services and support to teens and Women of childbearing age. Free and Confidential services include pregnancy testing, health and Well-being classes, one-on-one support, informational resources, assistance With NJ Family Care applications, and referrals to WIC, Head Start, the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) and local health centers. The IPO program will offer Workshops on nutrition, stress management, prenatal care, childbirth preparation, baby care, and safety, and will Work With trained Community Health Workers to provide assistance in obtaining donations of folic acid, diapers, and other baby essentials.

Free Pregnancy Testing

Free and confidential pregnancy testing is available at our Family Success Centers. Call today to schedule your appointment or to learn about our convenient Walk-in test hours. Pregnancy test results are immediate, and are CLIA approved. Our friendly counselors are available to discuss your results and options and provide you With case management and refunds.

Mercer County WIC Program

New Jersey's Women, Infants and Children (WIC) supplemental nutrition program helps pregnant, breastfeeding and postpartum Women identify healthy food choices for themselves and their families. CHSofNJ is proud to sponsor the WIC program in Mercer County and provide these critical services to our community's Women, infants and children up to age five:

- ♥ Vouchers for free, supplemental nutritious foods
- ♥ Nutrition education and counseling
- ♥ Breastfeeding education and support
- ♥ Health care referrals
- ♥ Immunization screenings
- ♥ Voter registration

CUNA

CUNA, or “crib/cradle” in Spanish, is a health and social service program created for Mercer County's growing Latino community. CUNA provides linguistically and culturally appropriate prenatal and postnatal health education, parenting education, and support services for pregnant and parenting moms and dads in Mercer and Ocean County While promoting strong community support networks and friends.

CUNA is offered in partnership With Capital Health. Services are free and provided in a Welcoming and supportive environment.



The Trenton Women's Health Literacy Project

The Trenton Women's Health Literacy Project connects Mercer County's Women and adolescent girls to important health care resources. CHSofNJ Women's health advocates use a variety of free and confidential health examinations to identify appropriate health care linkages. Health advocates will also help participants complete the enrollment process for health insurance and prepare for various health care appointments.

Services are delivered in English and Spanish at various community locations throughout Mercer County.
