You Make the Choices



Being pregnant may have you scared and confused. With the help of The Children's Home Society of New Jersey you will not be alone. We will help and support you without judgment. Most of all we will respect your decision.

Consider the Following:

- ♥ Every option is explored.
- ♥ You may decide to parent your child.
- ♥ You may decide to place your child with an adoptive family.
- ♥ If you are continuing with your pregnancy, you do not need to make a permanent decision while you're pregnant.
- ♥ You may decide you need more time to make preparations and consider your choices.
- ♥ Services are also available to birth fathers.

Parenting Your Child

If you decide to parent your child:

- ♥ We can refer you to the right places for medical care and other needed services.
- ♥ We can help you learn to take care of your child.
- ♥ We can offer you supportive services.
- ♥ Services are based on your needs and the needs of your child.

Take Time to Consider Your Choices

If you need more time to consider your choices or make preparations:

- ♥ Don't make a hasty decision.
- ♥ You can choose to place your child with one of our loving, temporary child care families at no cost to you.
- ♥ You can visit your child while he or she is with a child care family.
- ♥ The child's medical care will be provided free of charge.
- ♥ Counseling services are available to you even after you make a decision.
- ♥ All services are Free and Confidential.

Placing Your Child With an Adoptive Family

As the birthparent, you have the option to make all the decisions. If you decide adoption is best:

- ♥ You can choose adoptive parents for your child from among our approved families.
- ♥ You can allow us to choose the caring adoptive family, and you do not need to have any contact with the family.
- ♥ You can choose an adoptive family known to you.
- ♥ You can meet the adoptive family.
- ♥ You can hear about your child as he or she grows and receive photographs.
- ♥ You can place your child with an adoptive family directly from the hospital
