The New Jersey State Council on the Arts Awards \$19,000 Grant in Support of Trenton Education Dance Institute

Trenton, NJ (October 23, 2017) – The New Jersey State Council on the Arts (NJSCA) has awarded a \$19,000 grant to The Children's Home Society of New Jersey (CHSofNJ) in support of the agency's Trenton Education Dance Institute (TEDI) program.

TEDI, a National Dance Institute modeled dance and education program for the development of Trenton youth, is offered in collaboration with the Trenton Board of Education, and designed to complement lessons learned in the classroom. As a result of this generous award from NJSCA, TEDI will be incorporated into the curriculum of six fifth grade classes at P.J. Hill Elementary School and three fifth grade classes at Parker Elementary School for the 2017-18 school year.

CHSofNJ President & CEO Donna Pressma elaborated on the importance of the NJSCA grant; "This generous grant from The New Jersey State Council on the Arts reinforces the importance of TEDI and amplifies our ability to provide this creative and expressive program that helps Trenton youth build confidence and develop critical life skills that will lead to success in school and life."

Under the dynamic leadership of CHSofNJ's Director of School Based Services Louise McCants, the 2017-18 school year will see an increase in TEDI community performances, allowing students the opportunity to dance in front of large audiences and draw on many of the skills learned through TEDI such as confidence, teamwork, perseverance, and pride in personal achievement.

President of the TEDI Board of Directors Richard Bilotti commented, "We are so grateful to the New Jersey State Council on the Arts for this generous support that will help TEDI enhance the lives of more Trenton youth."

This spring, CHSofNJ plans to celebrate TEDI's 29th year by returning the program's finale performance and reception to Patriots Theater at the War Memorial in Trenton. Details will be announced at www.chsofnj.org as the event approaches.
