



**KINSHIP CARES ENHANCED NAVGATOR PROGRAM
LOGIC MODEL**

Vision: Kin caregivers will have a greater ability to provide for their needs and the needs of their children due to lower stress, changes in parenting and child development knowledge and skills, and access to resources to help maintain their family. Families will achieve stability in their children’s living arrangements and gains in their adjustment and well-being.

Target Population: Adults raising related children in their home without the presence of the children’s biological parents. Caregivers may include grandparents, siblings, aunts, uncles, cousins, etc.
